## 2024/2025 MATRICULATION CEREMONY AND CLOSURE OF THE REGISTRATION PORTAL FOR THE FRESHMEN

- I write to inform the entire University Community and in particular all fresh students admitted in the 2024/2025 academic session that Matriculation Ceremony for this set of students is scheduled to hold on Saturday, 29th March 2025 at 10.00 a.m. prompt.
- 2. The venue is the University Auditorium, Rumuolumeni Campus.
- 3. Accordingly, all fresh students are advised to ensure that they complete all registration formalities **not later than Friday, 14**th **March, 2025.** Matriculation Numbers will be assigned to only those that have duly registered and paid all fees. Matriculating students should pay the sum **of N10,000.00** (Ten Thousand Naira) only as cost of hiring of the Matriculation gown. **All payments must be made on- Line to Ignatius Ajuru University of Education, Rumuolumeni, Port Harcourt.**
- 4. All fresh students should take notice that:
- (a) Any student who fails to complete registration formalities and pay his/her school fees **before the closure of the portal on Friday, 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2025** ceases to be a student of Ignatius Ajuru University of Education, Port Harcourt.
- (b) Only students who present evidence of payment of the gowns will be allowed to sign the Matriculation Register at the Departments and Faculties.
- 5. No unsigned Matriculation Number will be accepted for official documentation in the University. Collection of matriculation gowns from Faculty Officers would commence on **Friday**, 21st March 2025.

- 6. All part-time students are requested to collect their Matriculation gowns from the Centre for Continuing Education (CCE) at the St. John's Diobu Campus, but join their various Faculties in the procession and matriculation.
- 7. In the same vein, all Students of the Institute for Distance Learning (IDL) should collect their Matriculation gowns from the IDL but also join their various Faculties in the procession and matriculation.
- 8. Matriculation marks the end of registration for the academic session. Any student who fails to register before the **Matriculation Ceremony** will cease to be a student of the University as no registration will be allowed thereafter.
- 9. All academic gowns collected must be returned to the Faculty Officer latest on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025. Defaulters will be made to pay a penalty of N2,000.00 (Two Thousand Hundred Naira) only per day.
- 10. Furthermore, all fresh students who have completed registration and paid school fees, should report at the **Information** and **Communication Technology (ICT) Centre** to be captured for **Identity Card** (ID) production.
